**Advice Letter PCE AL 009 E-A** 

RE: SUPPLEMENT TO ADVICE LETTER PCE 009-E, SUBMITTAL OF COMMUNITY CHOICE AGGREGATOR FINANCIAL SECURITY REQUIREMENT INSTRUMENT

#### **PURPOSE**

Peninsula Clean Energy Authority ("<u>PCE</u>") is submitting this supplemental advice letter related to its Community Choice Aggregator ("<u>CCA</u>") Financial Security Requirement ("<u>FSR</u>") Instrument pursuant to additional guidance provided by the California Public Utilities Commission ("<u>Commission</u>") Energy Division. A fully executed version of the FSR Instrument is appended hereto as Confidential Appendix B.

#### **BACKGROUND**

In compliance with Resolution E-5059 and Decision ("<u>D.</u>")18-05-022, PCE submitted Advice Letter PCE 009-E on December 16, 2020. As an appendix to Advice Letter 009-E, PCE submitted a pro-forma version of its CCA FSR Instrument. In addition, pursuant to previous guidance provided by the Energy Division, PCE included an attestation in Advice Letter 009-E by which PCE affirmed that its FSR Instrument had been formed and that Pacific Gas and Electric Company had been made the FSR Instrument's obligee, recipient or equivalent, as directed in Resolution E-5059. PCE also included a request within Advice Letter 009-E that the interim FSR amount of \$100,000 be returned to PCE. This request was made in accordance with Resolution E-5059 and D.18-05-022, which state that the interim financial security posted with the Commission should be returned to the posting CCA when the CCA complies with the new financial security requirements.<sup>1</sup>

On January 8, 2021, the Energy Division distributed an email to CCAs advising the CCAs that the interim FSR amount of \$100,000 would be returned to the CCAs once the CCAs have submitted executed FSR Instruments as a supplement to their respective FSR advice letters. Pursuant to instructions set forth in the email from the Energy Division, PCE is submitting this supplemental advice letter containing a confidential version of PCE's executed FSR Instrument.

#### REOUEST FOR RETURN OF INTERIM SECURITY

PCE previously posted an interim FSR of \$100,000 with the Commission in compliance with

Resolution E-4133. As noted above, per Resolution E-5059 and D.18-05-022, the interim financial security posted with the Commission should be returned to the posting CCA when the CCA complies with the financial security requirements as described in Resolution E-5059.<sup>2</sup> Through this supplemental advice letter, PCE is renewing its previous request for the return of the interim FSR amount of \$100,000.

#### **EFFECTIVE DATE**

PCE requests that this supplement to Advice Letter 009-E become effective concurrent with the submission of the original advice letter on December 16, 2020.
